

PRIVACY STATEMENT

SAP and the VNSG (association of Dutch-speaking SAP users) treat your personal data on the basis of the relevant, national and European, privacy laws.

Purpose of personal data processing

In order to ensure proper handling of your registration for Connect to Innovate, it is necessary for you to provide us with all personal and other data that are relevant for the registration. This data provided by you enables us to serve you effectively and inform you about Connect to Innovate.

The personal and other data provided by you:

- will only be used for the purpose for which you have provided them,
- may be used for marketing purposes of SAP SE and all affiliated businesses,
- will only be shared with parties that participate in this event (such as sponsors, SAP, VNSG).

If you use the mobile event app, you accept that your data will also be shared with other participants who use the same mobile app for this event.

Protection of personal data

We treat your personal and other data with due care and comply with the relevant laws and regulations. Our staff are bound by a duty of confidentiality and their employment contracts contain a penalty clause for infringements of the confidentiality clause.

All personal data provided by you or matters that are important for the services rendered to you are treated as strictly confidential.

In addition, we take the following measures to reduce the risk of loss of personal data to a minimum:

- We ensure good security of our offices and our systems.
- If we use third parties, we impose at least the same security requirements on those third parties.
- Data are only processed by us by those for whom this is necessary as part of their job.
- The personal and other data are not stored by us for longer than is necessary, but they are stored, as a minimum, for the duration of the statutory retention period applying to us.

Your rights

You have the following rights under the privacy laws:

- right of access to your personal data;
- right to rectification of your personal data;
- right to erasure of your personal data (with consequences for membership);
- right to object to (to oppose) certain ways of using your personal data;
- right to data portability (the right to transmit your personal data to another provider of ICT services).

Visit to our website

When these web pages are visited, the following data are automatically saved in a protocol and processed for the purposes of the services we provide: date and time of the page request, URL of the request, browser used (user agent), success or failure of the request (status of the request), size of the data received and sent, runtime.

Processing those data is necessary for technical reasons to be able to provide the service; the data can also be used to compile internal system and use statistics. However, this does not involve data that can be traced to specific persons. Pseudonyms are used insofar as statistics are compiled to design the web page in accordance with users' wishes.

Cookies are used on an incidental basis when these web pages are visited. Cookies are stored in your browser to increase service quality. The cookies used are known as "session cookies", which automatically expire after your browser is closed and are deleted, depending on the method set in your browser. You can prevent the use of cookies in general by choosing the appropriate setting for this in your browser. This may, however, lead to limitations of the functionality of the web pages.
